Introduction:

Earth Day is an annual event most commonly celebrated on the April 22. Earth Day is a day on which people around the world gather to participate in activities and demonstrations aimed at raising public awareness about a variety of environmental issues including air pollution, water pollution, habitat destruction, renewable energy, climate change, species losses, and environmental policies. The history of Earth Day is rooted in the 1970s, during a time when the modern environmental movement was gaining momentum. In conjunction with this significant day, MAAP is leading an initiative to increase awareness and educate students on the eco-knowledge and green sustainability by conducting this project.

List of Activities

1. Ice Breaker & Introduction

2. Presentations from SUSI Alumni

Three SUSI alumni who went for Global Environmental Issues or Fulbright alumnus will take turn to speak and present on the following topics:

1. History of Earth Day
2. 3Rs (Reduce, Reuse and Recycle)
3. How to reduce Global Warming?
4. The threats and future of wildlife in Malaysia. (TBC)

Students will be encouraged to ask questions in relations to the topics presented. This interactive session will also include a quiz session to test their comprehension on the presentations. The student with the highest scores will get a mystery gift. The questions will be derived from the content of the presentations.

3. Group Activity

Alumni will be divided into 5 groups and asked to create a 'GREEN PRODUCT' out of recyclable items such as news paper, plastic bottles and etc. that will be provided by the project committee. They are given 30 minutes to complete the task and highlight the usage of it. The most impressive "GREEN PRODUCT" will win a prize. The goal of this activity is to sharpen their creativity skills and expose them on hands-on experience using recycle items.

4. Individual Activity

Each student will be asked to come up with an idea on "How do you save trees?"

5. Tree Planting

This would be a symbolic activity as a wrap of the day.

1. To propose Ambassador to make an appearance during closing ceremony. (For tree planting & prize giving ceremony)

Estimated Budget

1. Plants = RM 100
2. Props & items for activities = RM 100
3. Prizes = RM 50
